House Bill 404 - "AN ACT CREATING THE "DEFEND THE GUARD ACT", REQUIRING AN OFFICIAL CONGRESSIONAL DECLARATION OR ACTION TO RELEASE THE MONTANA NATIONAL GUARD TO ACTIVE COMBAT DUTY; PROVIDING POWERS OF THE GOVERNOR REGUARDIING THE MONTANA NATIONAL GUARD, PROVIDING DEFINITIONS; AND PROVIDING AN IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVE DATE."

To be heard in the House Energy, Technology, and Federal Relations (ETFR) Committee Wednesday, February 26th, 3 pm, Room 472.

This bill jeopardizes MTNG missions, end strength, equipment, and funding:

- This bill is on a fast track to be passed in the House.
- This law would relegate our Montana National Guard to nothing more than a peacetime force, inaccessible by the Department of Defense for several missions, perhaps even precluding support of our State Partnership Program Nations or support of our troops at the Mexican Border.
- If the Montana National Guard cannot support all operations required by the President and Department of Defense, we will become the last to be called (if at all) and our missions, training, equipping and funding will be decimated
- Of the 2.1 million military members (AD, NG, Res), Montana National Guard is approximately 3,700. That is 17 ten thousandths of one percent (0.0017), hardly enough to fix the war declaration issue in our Congress
